TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER

Upon consideration of Plaintiff HONEYWELL INTERNATIONAL INC.'s motion for a temporary restraining order, and the entire record herein, and being fully advised in the premises, it shall be, and hereby is,


ORDERED this 24th day of September, 2010, that the Defendant UNITED STEEL, PAPER and FORESTRY, RUBBER, MANUFACTURING, ENERGY, ALLIED INDUSTRIAL AND SERVICE WORKERS INTERNATIONAL, AFL-CIO-CLC, LOCAL 7-669, and its officers, agents, members, servants, representatives, employees, and any other persons acting in concert or participation with them who receive actual notice of this order are hereby restrained from conspiring, combining, agreeing, or arranging with each other, or with any other person or persons, organizations or associations, from the following:

- (1) Placing nails at the entrances to Honeywell's Metropolis Plant.
- (2) Placing nails at locations where persons employed by or having lawful business with Honeywell have boarded buses for transport through Massac County to Honeywell's Metropolis Plant;

- (3) Using mirrors to flash light at vehicles entering or exiting Honeywell's Metropolis Plant or at individuals performing work at the Plant;
- (4) Placing objects in the entrances to the Metropolis Plant, thereby obstructing passage and impeding ingress and egress from Highway 45 to the Plant;
- (5) Obstructing, unnecessarily hindering, or delaying passage from Highway 45 to the Plant, or in any other way impede ingress and egress from Highway 45 to the Plant;
- (6) Damaging and threatening to damage vehicles of visitors to the Metropolis Plant;
- (7) Threatening physical harm to or otherwise intimidating or harassing individuals attempting to enter, exit, or otherwise conduct lawful business at the Metropolis Plant; or
- (8) In any other way creating an obstruction to the free, safe flow of traffic in both directions on the road leading to the Metropolis Plant or any other public road leading to the Plant.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Defendant, through their officers and agents, communicate or cause to be communicated forthwith to all of their members, by means reasonably calculated to insure speedy receipt thereof, the fact that this Order has been entered by this Honorable Court, effective immediately, and the contents of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiff be granted its costs and disbursements
of this suit.
